Frederick Wilson, Jr. was born April 21, 1947, in Florence County to the late Frederick Wilson, Sr. and the late Hattie Spann Wilson. He transitioned peacefully from this life on July 30, 2023, after an illness.

Frederick grew up in a rural section of Timmonsville, SC and matriculated through the local schools there. He was a 1965 graduate of Johnson High School. After graduating high school, Frederick married the former Margaret Ann Daniels who preceded him in death. They were married for 50 years and had four children: Shannin Nicole, Tonya LeBrenadette, Frederick III, and Joi Kimiko.

After graduating high school, Frederick began working for the railroad stationed in Florence, SC. He joined at a time when race was an issue. Frederick proved that despite the barriers, he could become the best trainman the world has ever seen. He was hired in 1966 as a trainman for the Atlantic Coastline Railroad, which underwent a couple of name changes (Seaboard Coastline Railroad and

present-day CSX Railroad). He also worked as a conductor for Amtrak trains.

In January of 1977, he

was afforded the opportunity to be a conductor on the Amtrak "Peanut Special" for president elect

Jimmy Carter that traveled from Plains, GA to Washington D.C. carrying supporters of President

Carter. He was a long-time member of the United Transportation Union.

Frederick work for the

railroad for 42 consecutive years.

Frederick has been a lifelong attendee and member of the Mt. Carmel Baptist Church. He

devoted numerous hours at the church doing what needed to be done. He served in the capacity as

Chairman of Trustees where he worked relentlessly on the improvement of the building and the

financial stability of the church.

Along with his parents and wife Margaret, Frederick was preceded in death by his sisters Martgree

Cunningham and Jannie Ham.

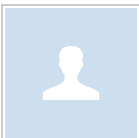
