



Rev. Henry B. Peoples

September 6, 2022

Reverend Dr. Henry Brasker Peoples of Timmonsville, SC entered into the joy of the Lord on Tuesday, September 6, 2022. He was preceded in death by his parents, John Peoples, Sr. and Annie Allen Peoples; his wife Etta Washington Peoples; four brothers, John Peoples, Jr., James Peoples, Hyman Peoples, Sr. and William Peoples; and three sisters, Patricia Solomon, Ella Sansbury and Beulah Fitzgerald.

Reverend Peoples was born in Darlington County on September 29, 1942. He was a graduate of Johnson High School in Timmonsville, SC and Morris College School of Religion in Sumter, SC. He received a B.A. degree in Business Administration from Ashford University in Clinton, IA. He completed studies at the University of Maryland in Baltimore, MD and University of Biblical Studies in Bethany, OK. He was a graduate of the Institute of South Carolina Municipal Government in Columbia, SC. He received his honorary Doctor of Theology Degree from the St. Thomas Christian College of Jacksonville, FL.

Reverend Peoples was a man of many talents as he served his community. He was an entrepreneur and had an insatiable interest in upholstery. He became known as the skilled owner of Peoples' Upholstery servicing the Pee Dee and surrounding areas. He was called to preach on February 16, 1971, and delivered his first sermon at Chaney Grove Missionary Baptist Church in

Timmons ville, SC. He was ordained by the Pee Dee Baptist Association on February 23, 1972. In February 2022, he celebrated fifty years of ministry – teaching, preaching, reaching others, and changing lives through Christ. Reverend Peoples was the founding pastor of Zion Canaan Missionary Baptist Church of Timmons ville, SC. He previously served as pastor of Marion Baptist Church of Salters, SC for sixteen years; Hopewell Baptist Church in Georgetown, SC for nine years; Bethlehem Baptist Church in Timmons ville, SC for four years; Pleasant Grove Baptist Church in Darlington, SC for six years; Chaney Grove Baptist Church in Timmons ville, SC for one year and Old Field Baptist Church in Mullins, SC for three years. He was the immediate past moderator of the Pee Dee Baptist Association.

Reverend Peoples was a loyal and committed pillar in his community. He was elected as a member of the Timmons ville Town Council and served two four-year terms. He was elected as mayor of the Town of Timmons ville, SC and served three four-year terms. He was the founder of Friends United, Inc., a 501(c)(3) grassroots organization chartered to offer educational enrichment services and to fight food insecurity in the Timmons ville community.

Reverend Peoples was named “Man of the Year” and received the South Carolina Southeast Leadership Award on February 12, 2012. Most notable, Highway 76 from I-95 to Timmons ville city limits is now named the Reverend Dr. Henry B. Peoples Highway. He was vice-chair of the Morris College Board of Trustees and a member of Riven Rock Masonic Lodge #60 in Timmons ville, SC.

Those left to cherish his precious memories are: His wife, Mrs. Beatrice J. Peoples; seven children, Valerie Hyman of Sacramento, CA, Iris (Joe) Green of Garner, NC, Alton Craig Peoples of Baltimore, MD, Darron (Tangie) Peoples of Darlington, SC, Hope Simon of Columbia, SC, Shelah (Charles) Verette of Florence, SC, and Bridgett (Selwyn) Mitchell of Lexington, SC; one

sister, Nora (Danny) Attenborough of Timmonsville, SC; two aunts, Rachel Brown of Florence, SC and Ada Allen of Bridgeport, CT; nineteen grandchildren, nine great grandchildren, Zion Canaan Missionary Baptist Church family; and a host of in-laws, nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.

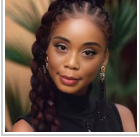

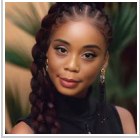
