Mrs. Eaddy affectionally called “Sue” by her family members, made a peaceful transition to her heavenly home on April 5, 2021 in the comfort of her home. She was born in Effingham, SC to the late Augustus Law and Louise Cooper Law. She was educated in the Florence Public School System. After marrying the love of her life, the late Reverend Dr. Solomon Eaddy, Sr., she devoted her time to raising her children while her husband served in the Navy and as a prize fighting boxer in New York City.
